1. My parents were living on 6 acres which is mostly wooded. All the wooded area is a debris field and cleaning it up is the biggest need at the moment. **If you would like, feel free to come to Perryville at any time for any length of time to pick up debris and pile it near the road for future pickup.** The debris consist of anything foreign besides the tree limbs. Work gloves, boots and warm clothes are recommended. If I am not there, just tell whoever is there how you know me and you came to help. Large black trash bags for small debris are available onsite.
